Deadline to submit this form for full-time students starting September 2011 is Friday, September 30, 2011; starting January 2012 is Friday, February 3, 2012; and starting May 2012 is Friday, June 1, 2012. If your program has an alternate start date (other than September or January or May), your application is due 30 days after your program starts. **Please note** – if you are an International student, or are funded through Second Career you are not eligible for this bursary.

To ensure that you are submitting current, accurate budget information, please do not submit your application more than one month before the due date. You will be notified of your eligibility via your Fleming email account. Bursaries will be available in mid November, early March, and late June for those who are eligible. **If you have an outstanding balance on your student account, your bursary will be applied to your account.** Any remaining balance will be issued to you by cheque.
