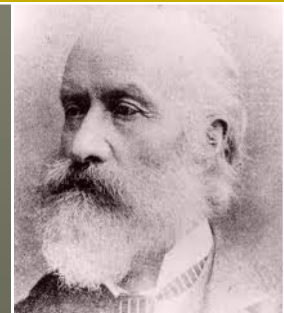

Students are invited to meet at 4:00 pm in the Aboriginal Student Lounge (Rm 372). Aboriginal Student Success Facilitator, Kylie Fox, will provide you with a tour out to our Tipi on Campus. Please wear appropriate clothing and shoes as we will be walking outdoors.

TIPI TUESDAYS

Every Tuesday, a staff member from Aboriginal Support Services will be available inside the tipi between the hours of 10am and 3pm. The tipi, equipped with a traditional fire will provide a safe place to socialize and visit with one another. Sacred medicines will also be available for smudging inside the Tipi on these days. Please note that the Tipi is a sacred place, and there are certain protocols for using the Tipi that should be respected. If unaware of protocols, please see Kylie Fox prior to accessing this space. Miigwetch! (thank you)

MEN'S TRADITIONAL DRUMMING

Young Aboriginal Men at Fleming are encouraged to attend an open drum practice. The big drum is intended for men only, however, women are also invited to show our support for the men. Women – please feel free to bring your beadwork or material to work on your regalia (sewing machines available). Students are welcome to bring their children/families.

SHARING CIRCLE

Every 2nd and 4th Thursday of the month, an Aboriginal Student Support Staff member will facilitate a sharing circle in the Aboriginal Student Lounge. Sharing Circles will be open to all Aboriginal Students and will be an opportunity to get to know one another, share experiences, thoughts, feelings, etc. If interested in participating in a sharing circle, please contact Kylie Fox or Laraine Hale.
