PREPARING FOR MOVE-IN

As you know, your suite is furnished and major kitchen appliances (fridge, stove and microwave) are supplied. We suggest that you bring only necessary items for the first few weeks to avoid duplicates of items within your suite.

SUGGESTED ITEMS TO BRING WITH YOU	ITEMS SUPPLIED BY THE FROST RESIDENCE
Toiletries (soap, shampoo, toilet paper, kleenex etc.) Clothes (not too many) Posters & <u>White Hold-it</u> (refer to Student Handbook) Towels Sheets, blankets, comforter for a single bed Pillow Cooking utensils, dishes, cutlery Cutlery tray and drying rack for dishes Plastic containers (i.e. Tupperware) Clothes hangers Wastepaper basket for bedroom and bathroom Laundry basket, detergent, fabric softener Large garbage bags Groceries Cleaning supplies (non-abrasive), mop, broom, dustpan Alarm clock Personal belongings to set-up your new home First Aid Supplies (i.e. cough syrup, bandages, medicines) Small kitchen appliances (i.e. kettle, toaster) Sewing Kit Flashlight School supplies (i.e. stapler, pens, paper, binders) Drying rack for clothes	Refrigerator, stove, microwave Bedroom furniture (bed, closet, dresser, desk, desk chair) Love seat and coffee table in living room Kitchen Tables & Chairs in dining area Shower curtains Recycling containers Compost container Garbage container for kitchen Towel bar in bedroom Coat hook in bedroom Mirror in bedroom and washrooms Bulletin board on desk Vacuum cleaner (can be borrowed from the office) Ironing Board (in laundry room) OPTIONAL ITEMS TO BRING WITH YOU Computer Games, Sports Equipment Bicycle and lock (must be kept in bicycle shed) Umbrella Extra Lamp (halogen lamps are prohibited) Bath Mat Apartment size refrigerator/freezer

Additional furniture is not allowed. We **DO NOT PERMIT** sofas, futons, **table-size games** or other large pieces of furniture to be moved into the Frost Residence. Any specialized (medical) equipment such as office chairs, mattresses, etc. must be cleared with the Manager of Housing & Conference Services **PRIOR TO MOVE-IN.**

There is no storage space available outside of your room, so we suggest that you bring **"necessities only"**.

The College assumes no liability for lost, stolen or damaged items of personal property, no matter how it is caused. It is the responsibility of the student to arrange for insurance coverage for personal property. We encourage you to contact an insurance company to arrange for Tenant Insurance or check your family policy, as it may cover your property.
