PREPARING FOR MOVE-IN

As you know, your suite is furnished and major kitchen appliances (fridge, stove and microwave) are supplied. We suggest that you bring only necessary items for the first few weeks to avoid duplicates of items within your suite.

<p>ETHERNET CORD FOR YOUR COMPUTER Toiletries (soap, shampoo, toilet paper, kleenex, etc.) Clothes (not too many) Posters & <u>White Hold-it</u> (refer to Student Handbook) Towels Sheets, blankets, comforter for a single bed Pillow Cooking utensils, dishes, cutlery Cutlery tray and drying rack for dishes Plastic containers (i.e. Tupperware) Clothes hangers Wastepaper basket for bedroom and bathroom Laundry basket, detergent, fabric softener Large garbage bags Groceries Cleaning supplies (non-abrasive), mop, broom, dustpan Alarm clock Personal belongings to set-up your new home First Aid Supplies (i.e. cough syrup, bandages, medicines) Small kitchen appliances (i.e. kettle, toaster) Sewing Kit School supplies (i.e. stapler, pens, paper, binders) Drying rack for clothes</p>	<p>Refrigerator, stove, microwave Bedroom furniture (bed, dresser, desk, desk chair and light) 3 Love seats, coffee table and end table in living room Kitchen table & chairs in dining area Shower curtains Recycling containers Compost container Garbage container for kitchen Towel bar in bedroom Coat hook in bedroom Mirror in bedroom and washrooms Tack board on desk Vacuum cleaner (1 per floor, borrow it by seeing your RA/SRA) Iron and Ironing Board (can be borrowed from office) OPTIONAL ITEMS TO BRING WITH YOU Computer Games, sports equipment Bicycle and lock (must be kept in bicycle storage room in Building 2) Umbrella Extra lamp (halogen lamps are prohibited) Bath mat Small refrigerator/freezer (max 5 cubic ft)</p>

Additional furniture is not allowed. We ***DO NOT PERMIT*** sofas, futons, **table-size games** or other large pieces of furniture to be moved into the Sutherland Residence Village. Any specialized (medical) equipment such as office chairs, mattresses, etc. must be cleared with the Manager of Housing & Conference Services **PRIOR TO THE DAY OF MOVE-IN**. We encourage you, if possible to bring a vacuum cleaner, you may borrow the one that is available on the floor but you are sharing it with 23 other students.

There is no storage available outside of your room; we suggest that you bring ***"necessities only"***.

The college assumes no liability for lost, stolen or damaged items of personal property, no matter how it is caused. It is the responsibility of the student to arrange for insurance coverage for personal property. We encourage you to contact an insurance company to arrange for Tenant Insurance or check your parents' policy, as it may cover your property.
