Due to the large size of the workforce and the relatively young age profile of workers, most job openings are expected to occur as workers leave for other jobs or advancement opportunities.</p> <p>Areas of notable growth within this occupation include mental health services, early childhood services, services to the elderly, and community-based outreach services.</p>
