Job Postings/Grad Report	2 Current job postings for the Muskoka/Kawartha Region (27 Oct. 2015) Fleming College grad report 2013/2014 indicates that 68% of grads are working in their field 6 months after graduation.
Additional Labour Market Information (LMI)	Muskoka Kawartha region
	For the 2014-2016 period, the employment outlook is expected to be fair (2 out of 3 stars) for Community and Social Service Workers (NOC 4212) in the Muskoka - Kawarthas region.
	This outlook is the result of an analysis of a number of factors that influence employment prospects in this occupation. Some of the key findings are that:

- Employment growth is expected to be moderate.
- A moderate number of people are expected to retire.
- This occupation has recently experienced low levels of unemployment. This occupation had a regional labour force of about 2,170 at the time of the 2011 National Household Survey.

Ontario Region

This occupation had a provincial labour force of about 52,255 at the time of the 2011 National Household Survey. Due to the large size of the workforce and the relatively young age profile of workers, most job openings are expected to occur as workers leave for other jobs or advancement opportunities.

Areas of notable growth within this occupation include mental health services, early childhood services, services to the elderly, and community-based outreach services.
