Additional Labour Market Information (LMI)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Employment growth is expected to be strong. • A small number of people are expected to retire. <p>2 of 3 stars</p> <p>For the 2014-2016 period, the employment outlook is expected to be fair for Plumbers (NOC 7251) in Ontario.</p> <p>A shift towards more water efficient plumbing systems may increase the demand for workers in this trade to replace old equipment with new integrated fixtures. Plumbers will need to be proficient with computer applications for design, layout and project management aspects. Also, workers will need to be familiar with new plumbing materials and tools such as prefabricated pipes and components along with measuring apparatuses. Employment opportunities may be better for those who are willing to travel to various locations for work or who possess credentials in other trades such as a gas fitter's licence. Plumbers may be required to work weekends and evenings especially for emergency repairs. Some of these skilled workers may also establish their own contracting firm as self-employment is rather common in this trade. (Release date: 2015-05-29)</p>
