## Fleming College Refund Policy

- If the college rejects an applicant prior to registration, a full refund of fees paid to that date will be made.
- In accordance with the Ministry of Training, Colleges and Universities Tuition Fee Operating Procedures, students must submit formal written notification of Withdrawal within 10 business days of the beginning of a semester to receive a refund of fees for the current term.
- If a student withdraws from their program after the tuition fee deadline as indicated in the letter of acceptance but prior to or on the tenth day of classes in a term, the tuition fee and ancillary fees minus a \$100.00 administrative fee will be refunded. **No refund will be made after 10 days.**
