Also, Fleming graduates are recognized as having good training and employers are active participants in Job Fairs that recruit Fleming graduates.</p> <p>In addition to the comments sourced directly from employers Indeed.com continues to profile drilling positions both in diamond, mining, environmental, geotechnical and well services, indicating a solid capacity for employment in Ontario.</p> <p>Grad Reports show 91.2 % of surveyed graduates are employed with 67.6% in a related job.</p>
Additional Labour Market Information (LMI)	<p>Graduates of this program have a better than 75% placement rate as stated by the Program Coordinator. Often as a result of the ties to the industry, employers come directly to the school to interview and offer employment to the graduates.</p>
