The New Pre-apprenticeship Electrician Program:

Job Readiness + Electrical Tools & Training + Paid Job Experience = Your Skills Toolbox

Classes take place at our new Kawartha Trades and Technology Centre.

This full-time (32-week) program starting March 23, 2015:

- Requires Grade 10 to be eligible
- Begins with in-class instruction, job readiness training and secondary trade training in Carpentry (8 weeks)
- Progresses to Electrical Training (12 weeks)
- Concludes with a Paid Work Placement (12 weeks)

When you complete this program, you will have the equivalent to Level 1 Basic Electrical Apprentice, job experience, the skills to search for and find employment, or pursue a full apprenticeship.

No cost to participants.

Tuition, text books, tools and safety equipment (hard hat, work boots, safety glasses) are covered.
