McMichael Canadian Art Collection

To reach the gallery from Hwy. 401:

Take Hwy. 400 north to Major Mackenzie Dr.
Turn left (west) on Major Mackenzie Drive to Islington Avenue.
Turn right (north) on Islington Avenue to the village of Kleinburg.

To reach the Gallery from Hwy. 407:

Take highway 400 north to Major Mackenzie Drive.
Turn left (west) on Major Mackenzie to Islington Avenue.
Turn right (north) on Islington Avenue into the village of Kleinburg.

To reach the Gallery from the QEW:

Take Hwy. 427 north till highway ends at Hwy. 7.
Turn right (east) on Hwy. 7.
Turn left (north) on Hwy. 27 (the second set of traffic lights).
Turn east (right) to Major Mackenzie Drive.
Turn left (north) at Islington Avenue at the first set of traffic lights into the village of Kleinburg.

Public Transit

Use the Toronto (TTC) and York Region (YRT) public transit systems to get to The McMichael.

Take the #37 TTC bus North from Islington Subway to Steeles Avenue. At Steeles, transfer to YRT bus #13A to Kleinburg. (Note: The #13A does not run on weekends, and only offers morning and evening service on weekdays.)

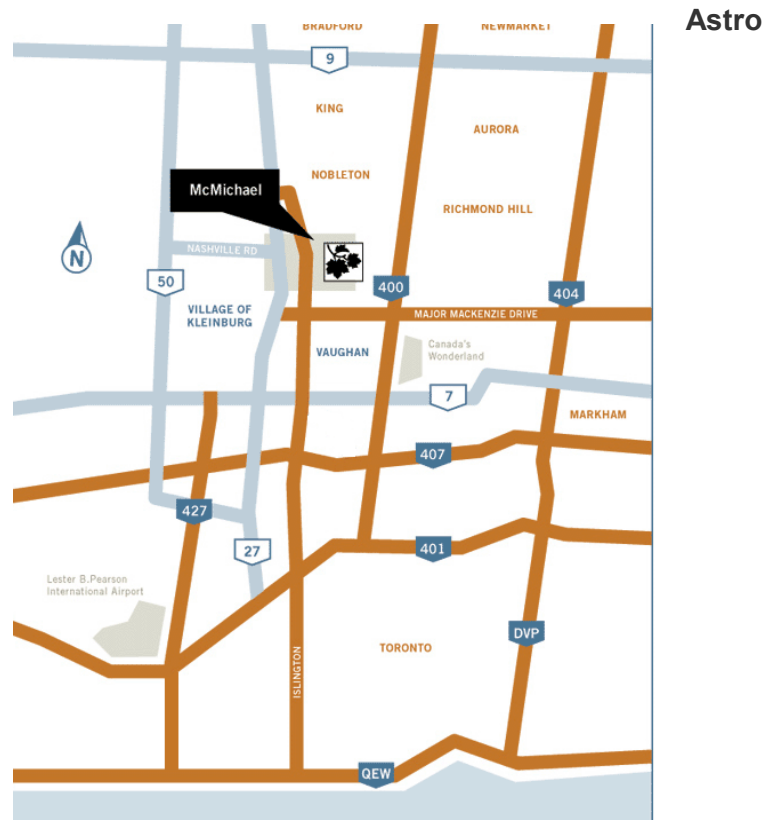

**Mandatory Studio Safety Practices apply – Reference the attached
NO OPEN TOE OR HEEL SHOES IN THE STUDIO**

There will be a \$10 material fee payable to the instructor. This fee will cover print materials and other related items necessary to fully participate in the course.

Please bring:

- Acrylics – 60 ml tubes and Titanium white in 200 ml size
- Oils – 37 ml size and Titanium White in 200 ml size
- Colours: Required - Alizarin Crimson or Permanent Rose
Cadmium Red Light Cadmium Yellow
Cadmium Yellow Light Cadmium Orange
Quinacridone Violet Pthalo Blue Red Shade or Cobalt Blue
Ultramarine Blue Titanium White (large tubes)
Zinc White or Mixing White (large tubes)
- Optional Colours: Pthalo Turquoise Cobalt Teal
Viridian or Pthalo Green Blue Shade
- Painting Mediums for oils – Gamblin Solvent Free Gel, Winsor & Newton Liquin Light Gel, cold wax medium, any brand
- Mediums for Acrylics – Matte Medium, I prefer Liquitex Ultra Matte and Matte Gel Medium
- Rags for oils and Paper towel for acrylics
- Artist Grade Odourless Mineral Spirits and a mason jar or lidded, sealable Brush Washer can, Curry's
- Canvas or wood paint panels or canvas boards:
 - 3 of 8 x 10
 - 2 of 12 x 16
 - 1 of 18 x 24 larger up to 24 x 30
- Brushes; Oil Brushes, natural bristle, flats, sizes = #8, #10, #12, #16
- Acrylic Brushes: Long Handle, Synthetic Bristle, not craft brushes.... Curry's Series 3800's are great sizes, ½ ", wide, ¾" wide, 1 "wide
- Palette knives – bent handle, long taper 2 -2 ½ long blade
- Stand up Easels or solid table top easel large enough for the surfaces we are using
- Palette Paper Pad, 12 x 16 minimum, 16 x 20 would be better

Mandatory Studio Safety Practices

Your health and safety is our priority. Our studio environments can have a number of objects, tools and chemicals that require personal protective equipment (PPE) or other consideration for your wellbeing. All persons (including faculty, staff and students) are asked to observe the following while in the shops and studios:

- ✓ **Wear sturdy and appropriate shoes such as sneakers, closed leather shoes or work boots – *open-toed shoes, flip-flops or high heels are not allowed***
- ✓ **No long, dangling clothing or accessories** (scarves, flowing sleeves, chains, long necklaces, etc.)
- ✓ **Long hair must be tied back**
- ✓ **No bare skin if exposure to chemical or tools/machinery is likely**
- ✓ **Appropriate PPE is mandatory when operating tools and equipment within the studios.** Please consult with the faculty or studio technician to determine the appropriate PPE required for specific machines and studio processes.

Fit tests are required for courses requiring a respirator as noted on your material list. Arrangements will be made on site.

As these are mandatory safety practices, we will follow up directly with students who may have oversights the above. Individuals may be asked to address any concerns before continuing to work in the studio.

Be sure to buy appropriate, good quality safety articles and equipment i.e. safety boots, protective eyewear, hearing protection, work gloves, x-acto knives, etc. – ask your supplier for advice.
