Welcome and Essential Services Session:

This session will include a welcome from President Tony Tilly and the Dean of your school. You will learn about key services to support your transition to Fleming College.

*PSWC – Peterborough Sport and Wellness Centre:

Student volunteers will be available to escort you over to the Peterborough Sport and Wellness Centre for Welcome to Fleming sessions held at this location. Specific times for each program area have been designated so please read your academic orientation agenda to ensure you know your start time.

Various Program Sessions:

Program Coordinators/faculty will be in this session to greet you and introduce you to school protocols and leadership. This session will also introduce you to your student advisor; a designated staff member who will assist you through your first semester at Fleming. You will have the opportunity to meet other students in your program before classes begin. Volunteers will be on hand in the main foyer to help direct and/or escort you to your scheduled sessions.

Explore the Fleming Computer Network Drop-Ins:

This session will help students log into the Fleming Network, enter the student portal where you will find volumes of information on campus services, and access your Fleming email account. Changing your password and understanding your printing account will be explained as well as how to access your weekly class schedule, add courses, change your address, etc. While you are offered to attend a specific session based on your school of study, there will be flexibility to accommodate students who miss their assigned session.

There will also be a system expert on course selection available every day the first week from 11:00 am to 2:00pm to assist you with Course Selection/Add/Drop/Swap. Staff will help with any course selections and answer timetable questions.

Free Time?

Be sure to take advantage of any free time you will have before or after your Orientation session times. This is time available to you to visit the bookstore, arrange for Student ID, buy a parking pass, meal plan, locker etc.
