Minimum Admission Requirements

Students applying to Registered Nurse - Perioperative Nursing must meet the following requirements:

- » BScN Degree, Registered Nurse (RN) in good standing with the College of Nurses of Ontario.
- » Students with a RN Temporary License to practice will also be considered.

OSSD with majority of courses at College (C) or Open (O) unless otherwise stated.
Grade 12 C courses will be accepted where Gr 11 C course requirements are listed.
Where College level courses are listed, U and M courses will be accepted.
